## Feel At Home

Our chefs prepare fresh, nutritionally balanced meals which are taken in our dining room. Morning coffee and afternoon tea and cake are served in the lounge or to bedrooms, with a hot evening drink before retiring.

A welcoming lounge provides space where our residents can socialise and participate in activities and entertainment as they wish. A visiting PARCHE team also holds a monthly service here.

There is wifi throughout the Home and a lift and stairlift connects every floor. Most of our bedrooms have en-suite facilities, and we encourage residents to personalise their room with their own belongings to help them feel at home.





## A History of Care

Our Home was first established in the New Forest. It was named after Emilie Galloway whose daughter generously provided for it to be left in trust to provide care for 'elderly gentlefolk'.

The original property was sold in the 1950s and Tweed in Eastbourne was subsequently purchased with the approval of The Charity Commission. We have kept Emilie's name and some of her family's heirlooms remain at Tweed today.

Tweed is a non-profit-seeking charitable trust directed by Trustees. Our team is passionate about providing exceptional care and we are proud of our long-standing reputation.
